olice forces the world over are reportedly worried by a new criminal organization that has surfaced, with its tentacles spread far and wide. 
free haven of Jaffna in the democratic Socialist Republic of S. Lanka.

TAI is said to be a fully streamlined service with branches in most western capitals and a strong presence in both India and Pakistan. All it does is charge a royalty, paid in US dollars or any other convertible currency, to permit any police force, government information department or enterprising politician to claim that any embarrassing -assassination, or convenient killing, has been done by the Tamil Tigers.

Once the Tigers are blamed for a killing, TAI ensures that one of their foreign offices will issue a routine denial which is not taken seriously by anybody. The service includes the supply of ID cards to be placed near the body of an alleged assassin, or even the supply of bodies to be identified as that of the assassin. On the pay-
