Rebel leader orders Sri Lankan ceasefire

COLOMBO — The leader of the Tamil Tiger rebels announced a unilateral ceasefire hours after the inauguration of Sri Lanka's new president. In a message broadcast over the Tigers' radio station, Velupillai Prabhakaran said the guerrillas should retaliate only if attacked. More than 34,000 people have been killed in the Tamil Tigers' 11-year war for a separate state in the north and east of this island off the tip of India.
